Responsibilities

As a school we will:

- provide a safe and happy environment where all children are valued, respected and listened to
- provide excellent teaching and an engaging curriculum to meet the needs of all children
- provide targeted and specialist support to help your child meet their full potential
- provide opportunities for your child to practise what they have learnt in school at home
- regularly share the progress of your child, through parent consultations, learning review days, annual reports and classroom visits opportunities
- support your child to develop a moral and ethical compass for life enabling them to grow up to be the best person they can be through our PSHE and citizenship opportunities
- achieve high standards of behaviour by providing opportunities for children to develop positive social relationships, self-esteem and a sense of responsibility
- teach your child to develop a positive attitude to others, learning about diversity and equality
- respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child
- provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, and events by keeping our website up-to-date, emailing a fortnightly newsletter and updating an annual calendar of events at regular intervals

- interact with all parents/carers with courtesy and kindness

We recognise that significant and positive impact adults at home can have on your child's success at school. Therefore, we ask that you commit to the following:

As a Parents/carers I will:

- make sure my child attends school regularly and is in the classroom by 8:45am wearing school uniform (or PE kit on the appropriate day)
- Nursery AM 8:30 – 11:30am
- let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning, behaviour or ability to do home learning, as this can then be resolved quickly
- support Foxborough Primary's ethos by encouraging my child to develop a positive attitude towards every member of our community and beyond
- support the school with their Behaviour Policy
- attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning
- support and work with the school to ensure that the behaviour policy of the school is maintained
- respect the confidentiality of each child
- regularly read information on the website, newsletters and letter so I am kept-up-to-date with important details of relevant policies, meetings, events and information about my child
- support the home learning policy
- interact with all members of staff with courtesy and respect
- inform the school of any medical issue and provide medication where appropriate (e.g. allergies and EpiPens) at the earliest opportunity

We teach the children to develop responsibility and agency for their own actions. Therefore, we ask all pupils to commit to the following:

As a pupil I will:

- act in line with our school values at all times
- come to school regularly and on time
- wear school uniform (or PE kit on appropriate days), be tidy in appearance and hygienic
- follow our school rules and behaviour policy
- accept responsibility for the things that I do
- be responsible for my school and home learning
- take good care of the building, equipment and school grounds
- reflect on my behaviour and learning and learn from all experiences
- tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is the school's primary priority and we expect parents to work with the school to ensure that their children are safe at all times.

Responsibilities

The school will:

- educate our children on how to stay safe including the safe use of the internet and technology and gaming, and will provide information to parents on how to keep their children safe
- fulfil our statutory obligations including reporting any safeguarding concerns to the appropriate bodies

Parents/carers will:

- ensure that your child(ren) has no access to inappropriate materials be it gaming, media (T.V./films/on demand) or social media
- ensure that your child is kept safe online and is safeguarded from risk and access to damaging content (e.g. graphic violence and sexualised imagery)
- understand that repeated failure to protect the safety of their child(ren) may lead the school to refer to external agencies
