Dear Parents and Carers

Reminder: Our Behaviour Policy – Rewards and Sanctions

At Foxborough Primary School, we are proud of the calm, positive and respectful environment that our children help to create every day. Our Behaviour Policy is designed to promote kindness, responsibility and learning through our three simple expectations:

Be Ready – Be Respectful – Be Safe

We believe that children learn best in an atmosphere of encouragement and mutual respect, where positive behaviour is recognised and celebrated.

Praise and Rewards

We place great emphasis on celebrating effort, kindness and positive choices. Staff make sure that praise is genuine, meaningful and timely. Praise is given for something truly praiseworthy, not just expected behaviour.

Children may receive:

- Rock points for showing any of the ROCK values
- “We ROCK” postcards or positive phone calls home
- Celebration assemblies and class celebrations
- Golden Time or special privileges
- Opportunities to take on leadership roles such as Junior Leader or House Captain

Our aim is to make every child feel proud, motivated and valued for the contribution they make to our school community.

Responding to Behaviour That Needs Support

Sometimes, children make choices that go against our expectations. When this happens, staff guide them calmly to reflect and make better decisions next time.

We use a **three-step response system** to ensure fairness and consistency:

Response 1 – Reminder:

A calm, gentle reminder of expectations (“Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe”).

Response 2 – Warning:

A clear warning and opportunity to correct behaviour.

Response 3 – Further Support:

If behaviour continues, the child may need reflection time, support from a learning mentor, or may miss a short part of break or lunch. Parents are informed whenever a Response 3 is given, and a restorative conversation takes place to help the child reflect, repair relationships and make a fresh start.



Serious Incidents

Certain behaviours result in an immediate Response 3, including but not limited to:

- Physical or racial abuse
- Swearing at staff
- Bullying or deliberate damage to property
- Behaviour that puts others at risk

In these cases, the school may apply further sanctions such as internal exclusion or suspension, following the guidance from Pioneer Educational Trust and the Department for Education.

Working Together

We deeply value our partnership with parents in promoting good behaviour and supporting every child to learn from their mistakes. Please continue to reinforce our expectations at home and celebrate your child's positive efforts.
