- A learning review meeting is a chance for parents/carers and the class teacher to hold a collaborative and formative discussion about the child's progress, achievements and wellbeing.

The school will not operate a normal day on Learning Review Day. However, attendance is expected for all pupils.

This year we will be running a **'Foxborough ROCKS!'** themed day.

- There will be 4 stations running throughout the day to encourage the children to interact with the school values- Responsibility, Open-Mindedness, Challenge and Kindness.
- All pupils will be given a 'passport' which will require them to attend each station and be signed by a supervising adult.
- Any child that completes their ROCK challenges and attends their parent-teacher meeting, will be awarded a ROCK certificate in assembly.
- Tea and coffee will be available all day for parents and carers in the main hall
- **Pupils must be accompanied by their adult at all times.**
