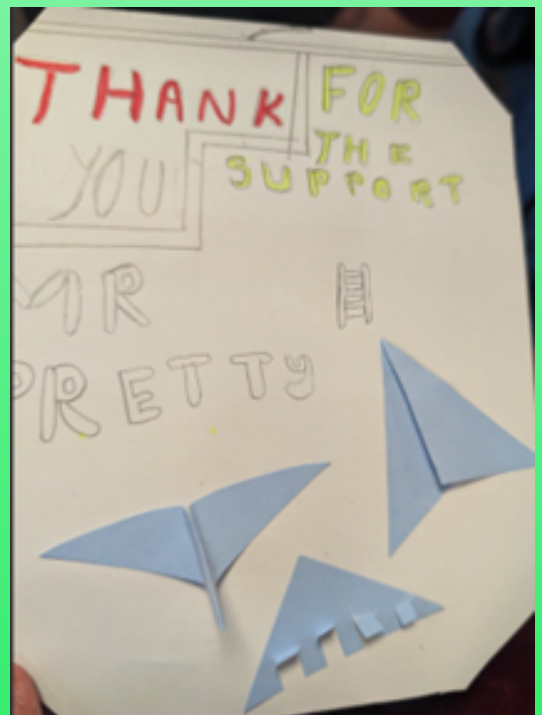
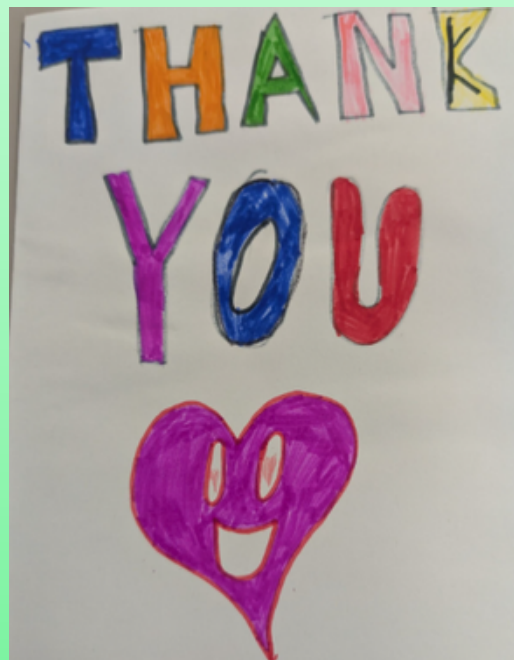
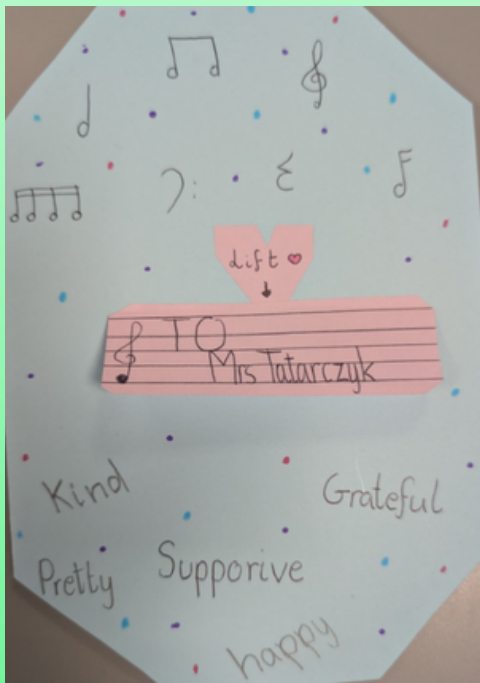


Super Work

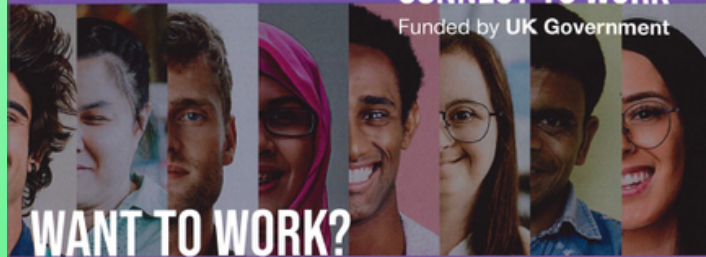
