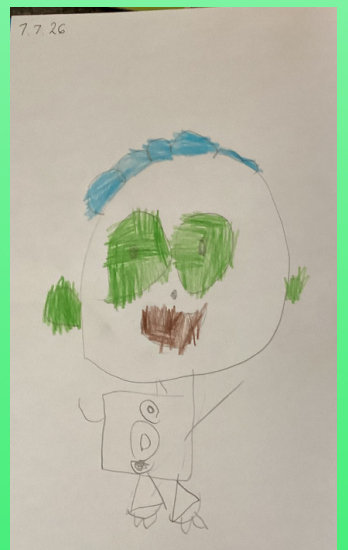
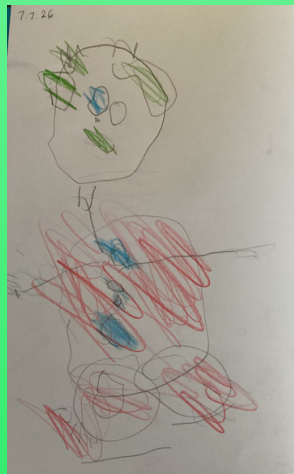
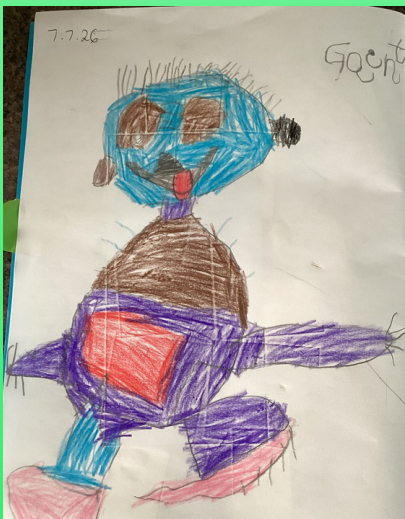
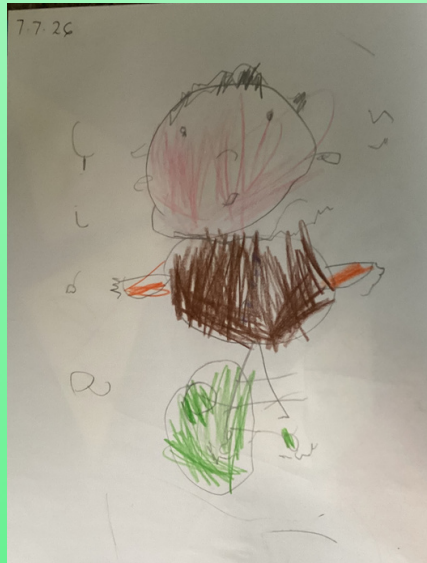
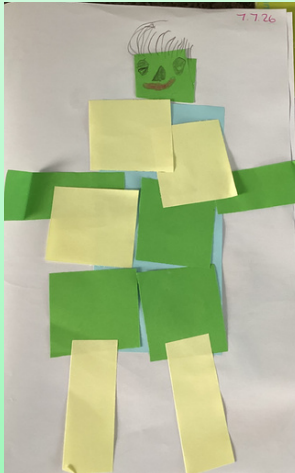


ART WEEK

Together we shine—in every hue.

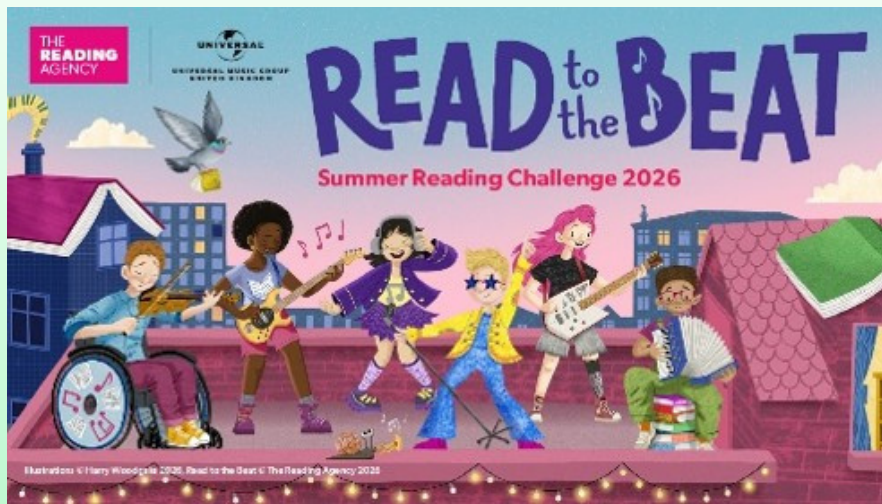
So here's to summer, and the year ahead,

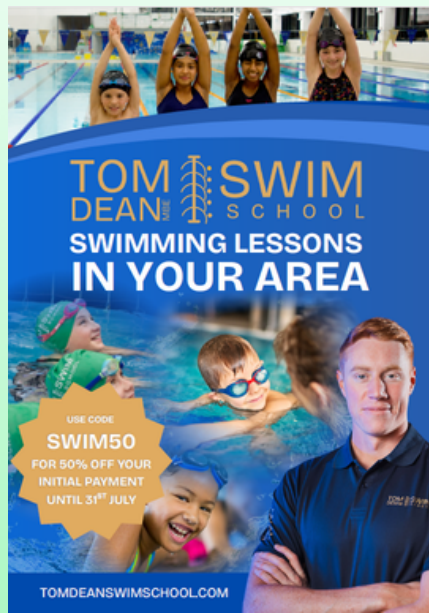
